Ysgol Uwchradd Tywyn Chwefror / February 2024

Mae'n bleser gennym gyhoeddi bod Ysgol Uwchradd Tywyn wedi cael ei dewis i gael ei chynnig ar gyfer pleidlais cwsmeriaid ar gyfer prosiect 'Tesco Stronger Starts'.
Bydd y pleidleisio'n dechrau yn y siop o ganol mis Ionawr 2024 tan ddiwedd mis Mawrth 2024.

Mae'r rhaglen grant Stronger Start, sy'n werth £5m, a gyflwynir mewn partneriaeth â Groundwork UK, yn helpu ysgolion a grwpiau plant i ddarparu bwyd maethlon a gweithgareddau iach sy'n cefnogi iechyd corfforol a lles meddyliol pobl ifanc, fel clybiau brecwast neu fyrbrydau, ac offer chwaraeon ar gyfer clybiau ar ôl ysgol.

Ychydig am ein prosiect:

Ein nod yn Ysgol Uwchradd Tywyn yw gwella iechyd a lles disgyblion drwy ymarfer corff yn yr awyr agored.

Hoffem gael 'Campfa Awyr Agored' lle bydd disgyblion a'r gymuned yn elwa o allu ymarfer corff i wella eu hiechyd a'u ffitrwydd.

Rydym yn gwybod bod ymchwil dda bod pobl ifanc sydd â gwell iechyd a lles yn llawer mwy tebygol o gyflawni eu nodau. Rydym yn teimlo y bydd cynnig lle awyr agored i ymarfer corff hefyd yn gwella sgiliau cymdeithasol, yn dod â disgyblion at ei gilydd i ffurfio cyfeillgarwch, ac i wella llythrennedd a hyder. Bydd disgyblion yn datblygu cydlynu wrth adeiladu ystywydher, cryfder cardiofasgwlaidd a chyhyrau. This £5m Stronger Starts grant programme, delivered in partnership with Groundwork UK, helps schools and children's groups provide nutritious food and healthy activities that support young people's physical health and mental wellbeing, such as breakfast clubs or snacks, and sports equipment for after school clubs.

A little about our project:

Our aim at Ysgol Uwchradd Tywyn is to improve pupils' health and wellbeing through exercise in the outdoors.

We would like to have an 'Outdoor Gym' where pupils and the community will benefit from being able to exercise to improve their health and fitness.

We know it is well researched that that young people with better health and well-being are far more likely to achieve their goals. We feel that offering an outdoor space to exercise will also improve social skills, bring pupils together to form friendships, and to improve literacy and confidence. Pupils will develop co-ordination while building agility, cardiovascular and muscle strength. We want to continue to promote well-being and adding an outdoor gym to our existing facilities, we can continue to promote physical/mental health opportunities for our pupils.



Rhaglen ARWR pysgod / Fish HERO programme



Rydym yn falch o gyhoeddi ein bod ni, fel ysgol, yn rhan o'r Rhaglen Arwr Pysgod.

Wedi'i gefnogi gan Ymddiriedolaeth Elusennol Pysgodfeydd Cwmni'r Gwerthwyr Pysgod, caiff Arwr Pysgod yr Ysgol ei reoli gan ganolfan yr Athrawon bwyd a'u tîm gwirfoddol ar draws y DU.

Cafodd y cynllun ei lansio yn 2020/21 a bydd y rhaglen yn ehangu drwy gydol y DU, gan gyrraedd dros 60,000 o ddisgyblion mewn 3 blynedd.

Cymerodd dros 900 o ysgolion ran yn 2022, gyda 13,000 o ddisgyblion yn cael cyfle unigryw i baratoi, coginio a blasu pysgod.

Mae Arwr Pysgod yr Ysgol yn ceisio sicrhau bod pob plentyn yn cael cyfle i baratoi, coginio a bwyta pysgod cyn iddynt adael yr ysgol. Bwriad y rhaglen yw hyfforddi dros 400 o athrawon bwyd ysgolion uwchradd i fod yn hyderus wrth baratoi a choginio pysgod gyda disgyblion yn eu dosbarthiadau.

Bydd athrawon yn derbyn cymorth gan arwyr lleol: gwerthwyr pysgod, cogyddion sy'n caru pysgod a chyflenwyr pysgod, yn ogystal ag arwyr eraill fydd yn mynychu ysgolion i drafod eu rolau wrth ddod ar bwyd o'r môr i'r plât, gan amlygu'r gyrfaoedd a'r cyfleoedd yn y diwydiant pysgod.

Fe wnaeth y disgyblion Ysgol Uwchradd Tywyn fwynhau coginio a dysgu am 'Gregyn gleision'.



We are pleased to announce that we, as a school, are part of the Fish Hero Programme.

Supported by the Fishmongers' company's Fisheries Charitable Trust, Fish In School Hero is managed by the food teachers centre and their volunteer team throughout the UK.

The scheme was launched in 2020/21 and the programme will be extending throughout the

UK, reaching over 60,000 pupils in 3 years. More than 900 schools took part in 2022, with 13,000 pupils having a unique opportunity to prepare, cook and taste fish

Fish In School Hero aims to ensure that every child gets a chance to prepare, cook and eat fish before they leave school. The programme aims to train over 400 secondary food teachers to be confident in preparing and cooking fish with students in their classrooms.

Teachers will be supported by local heroes: fishmongers, fish-loving chefs and fish suppliers, as well as other heroes who will be coming into schools to talk first-hand about their role in bringing seafood from the sea to the plate, highlighting careers and opportunities in the fish industry.

The pupils of Ysgol Uwchradd Tywyn enjoyed cooking and learning about 'Mussels'.





Trip Sgio / Blwyddyn 8 a 9 Ski Trip / Years 8 and 9

Dydd Gwener, Ionawr 12fed, 2024, cychwynnodd disgyblion Ysgol Uwchradd Tywyn ar daith sgiö gyffrous i'r Eidal. Dechreuodd cyfanswm o 43 disgybl o flynyddoedd 9 a 10, ynghyd â 5 aelod o staff, eu taith yn gynnar y bore Gwener hwnnw, gan gwmpasu pellter o 1063 milltir. Er gwaethaf yr amser teithio hir o bron i 30 awr, arhosodd disgwyliaid yn uchel gyda cyffro am yr wythnos i ddod yn cynyddu ymhlith disgyblion a staff.

Ar ôl iddynt gyrraedd Prato Nevoso, yr Eidal, ni wastraffodd y grŵp unrhyw amser i ollwng eu bagiau yn eu hystafelloedd cyn trefnu eu hoffer sgiö i baratoi ar gyfer yr anturiaethau i ddod. Roedd trefnu sgiö, esgidiau, helmedau a pholion yn eithaf tasg, ond llwyddodd y grŵp gyda phenderfyniad.

Ar ôl setlo i mewn, ymgasglodd y grŵp ar gyfer cinio haeddiannol cyn noswyllo. Y bore canlynol, fe wnaethant ymgynnull yn yr ystafell frecwast am 7:30 am, yn barod i ddechrau ar eu gwrs sgiö gyntaf o'r daith. Yn cerdded fel pengwiniad yn eu gêr sgiö, fe wnaethant fynd i'r llethrau, lle gwnaethant gyfarfod â'u hyfforddwyr am yr wythnos a dechrau'r wers ddwy awr gyntaf.

Yn dilyn egwyl ginio fer yn ôl yn y gwesty, dychwelodd y grŵp i'r llethrau ar gyfer sesiwn addysgiadol arall. Bob dydd daeth cynnydd a mwynhad newydd wrth i'r disgyblion hogi eu sgiliau ar yr eira. Yn ogystal â'u gwersi, fe wnaethant fwynhau moethusrwydd ymlacio yn y pwll ac archwilio siopau lleol. Fe ddaethon nhw o hyd i amser hyd yn oed ar gyfer rhai rasys cyfeillgar i lawr y llethrau, gan gynnwys cyfranogiad staff mewn tiwbiau eira.

Profodd y daith sgiö i fod yn brofiad gwerth chweil a chofiadwy i bawb a gymerodd ran, yn llawn chwerthin, dysgu, ac eiliadau bythgofiadwy ar flynyddoedd yr Eidal.

On Friday, January 12th, 2024, the pupils of Ysgol Uwchradd Tywyn embarked on an exhilarating ski trip to Italy. A total of 43 pupils from years 9 and 10, accompanied by 5 staff members, commenced their journey early that Friday morning, covering a distance of 1063 miles. Despite the long travel time of nearly 30 hours, spirits remained high as anticipation for the week ahead soared among both pupils and staff.

Upon their arrival in Prato Nevoso, Italy, the group wasted no time in dropping off their luggage in their rooms before organizing their ski equipment in preparation for the upcoming adventures. Sorting skis, boots, helmets, and poles proved to be quite the task, but the group managed it with determination.



The following morning, bright and early, they convened in the breakfast room at 7:30 am, ready to embark on their first ski lesson of the trip. Following a brief lunch break back at the hotel, the group returned to the slopes for another instructive session. Each day brought new progress and enjoyment as the pupils honed their skills on the snow. In addition to their lessons, they indulged in the luxury of relaxing in the pool and exploring local shops. They even found time for some friendly races down the slopes, including staff participation in snow tubing.

The ski trip proved to be a rewarding and memorable experience for all involved, filled with laughter, learning, and unforgettable moments on the mountains of Italy.

Yng Nghystadleuaeth Merched CyberFirst 2023/24, a gynhaliwyd gan Ganolfan Seiberddiogelwch Genedlaethol GCHQ, gwelwyd y nifer fwyaf o ferched yn cymryd rhan ers ei sefydlu.

Defnyddiodd y timau ystod o sgiliau seiber i gystadlu mewn cracio côd, dadgryptio negeseuon a datrys posau mewn cystadleuaeth sy'n ceisio ysbrydoli menywod ifanc i ddilyn gyrfaedd mewn seiber.

Some of our Year 8 girls have done amazingly well in this year's GCHQ Cyberfirst Competition and have come in the top 10 teams in the whole of Wales. They have been invited to a special celebratory event and 3 course meal in Newport in February to celebrate their achievement.

The 2023/24 CyberFirst Girls Competition, run by GCHQ's National Cyber Security Centre, saw the largest number of girls taking part since its inception.

Teams used range of cyber skills to compete in code cracking, decrypting messages and solving puzzles in a contest which seeks to inspire young women to pursue careers in cyber.

Rownd Derfynol Rhanbarthol F1 mewn ysgolion / F1 in Schools Regional Finals

Roedd 30 o ddisgyblion Ysgol Uwchradd Tywyn yn cystadlu yn Rownd Derfynol Rhanbarthol F1 mewn Ysgolion eleni a gynhaliwyd yn Ninbych yn gynharach y mis yma.

Wedi'i ddatblygu i gyflwyno myfyrwyr i bynciau STEM yn y ffordd fwyaf diddorol bosibl – drwy greu car F1 bach – mae F1 in Schools yn brosiect addysgol fel dim un arall. Wedi'i gynllunio ar gyfer athrawon, wedi'i lywio gan beirianwyr, ac wedi'i gymeradwyo gan F1, mae'r rhaglen hon yn gosod myfyrwyr ar y llwybr cyflym i lwyddiant STEM; ac mae'n darparu llawer o hwyl ar y ffordd.



Fel her sydd wedi'i gwreiddio mewn STEM, ond yn cwmpasu cymaint mwy, mae F1 in Schools yn rhoi cipolwg i fyfyrwyr ar amrywiaeth o yrfaedd a meysydd pwnc – o farchnata a nawdd i reolaeth ariannol, ochr yn ochr ag addysgu sgiliau technegol fel sut i ddefnyddio meddalwedd CAD (computer aided design) a pheiriannau CNC (computer numerical controlled).

Cafodd ein pum tîm, sy'n cynnwys disgyblion o Flwyddyn 8-11, y dasg o ddod o hyd i nawdd i'w helpu i brynu crysau a nwyddau tîm ar gyfer eu henw brand. Hoffem ddiolch i'r noddwyr canlynol am eu cefnogaeth:

Mae'r holl ddisgyblion wedi derbyn Gwobr Crest Stem Efydd i gydnabod eu hymdrechion gyda'u prosiectau a gronnodd i gannoedd o oriau.

Thirty pupils from Ysgol Uwchradd Tywyn competed in this year's F1 in Schools Regional Finals held in Denbigh earlier this month.

Developed to introduce students to STEM subjects in the most engaging way possible – through the creation of a miniature F1 car – F1 in Schools is an educational project like no other. Designed for teachers, informed by engineers, and endorsed by F1, this programme sets students on the fast track to STEM success; and provides a lot of fun on the way.




A challenge rooted in STEM, but encompassing so much more, F1 in Schools provides students with an insight into an array of careers and subject areas – from marketing and sponsorship to financial management, alongside teaching technical skills such as how to use CAD (computer aided design) software and CNC (computer numerical controlled) machines.

The STEM Co-ordinator at Ysgol Uwchradd Tywyn, **Amy Spencer**, who organised the teams has said; *"I am so incredibly proud of what our pupils have achieved. They have come together to produce the most amazing group projects, design & engineering portfolios, and pit displays. The future looks bright for these pupils in the world of STEM! I am very much looking forward to organising next year's competition to see what our teams can bring!"* All pupils have been awarded with a Bronze Stem Crest Award to recognise their efforts with their projects which accumulated to hundreds of hours.



Roedd Jo Edwards y Gweithiwr Ieuencid Ysgolion yn arwain y grŵp.


Pupils from year 8 and 9 took part in a Mental Health promotion activity day at Glanllyn on Monday 22nd January.
