To prepare for this journey, consider what you already know about communicating through writing including how and where to use capital letters and full stops and spaces between words. Additionally, try and think about your own techniques for remembering how to spell certain words.

During your journey you will ...

- Explore different methods of writing, before selecting which method suits you most effectively
- Consider the importance of legible hand writing including letter formation, writing on the lines and accurately spacing words
- Investigate the history of upper and lower case letters in order to develop your understanding of when to use the different forms and why
- Analyze sentences grammatically in order to verify that they are complete, as well as exploring the possibilities of sentence formation
- 5. Consider why written text is often structured in paragraphs before experimenting with paragraph production in your own writing
- 6. Combine what you have learned about written communication in order to produce effective and impactful pieces of writing
- Reflect on author Isaac Marion's assertion that 'writing isn't letters on paper. It's communication'
