Learn about the history of the monarchy and certain royal traditions.

Learn about HIV and the Aids virus, including how and why it can be transmitted.

Learn about gay marriage, the history of homosexual relationships and their equality in today's society.

Empathise with the characters and understand their motivations, opinions and points of view.
