We hope you look back on your time here with fondness and feel well-prepared for the next chapter of your lives, whether that involves further education, entering the workforce, or exploring new opportunities.


As you embark on this exciting new chapter, carry with you the lessons you've learned, the friendships you've made, and the memories you've created.

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

Roedd y disgylion wedi'u difyrru'n llwyr a mwynhau'r sioe yn fawr iawn.



Dechreuodd Dawn weithio fel cymhorthyyd dosbarth yn Ysgol Uwchradd Tywyn ym mis Medi 2016. Daeth ag angerdd a brwd frydedd dros Celf a Dylunio a chariad at weithio gyda phobl ifanc gyda hi. Roedd wedi ennill statws Myfyriwr y Flwyddyn ei hun tra'n dilyn ei chwrs Celf a Dylunio yn yr Ysgol Addysg a Dysgu Gydol Oes.

Tra'n gweithio mewn sawl maes o'r cwricwlwm gydag amrywiaeth o bobl ifanc o bob oed yn nyddiau cynnar eis gwaith yn yr ysgol, daeth yn amlwg yn fuan fod ei phrofiad a'i diddordeb mewn maes arbennig yn dod yn fwyfwy gwerthfawr. Roedd nifer y dysgwyr a ddewisodd ddilyn TGau Celf, Tecstilau a Dylunio Graffeg yn gyson uchel, ac roedd llawer yn gwerthfawrogi'r cyfle i weithio mewn grŵp bach ac ychydig yn arafach, rhywbeth yr oedd Dawn yn gallu ei gynnig o fewn amgylchedd yr ystafell ddosbarth.

Dawn began working as classroom assistant at Ysgol Uwchradd Tywyn in September 2016. She brought with her a passion and enthusiasm for all things Art and Design and a love of working with young people. She had achieved Student of the Year status herself whilst following her own course in Art and Design at the School of Education and Lifelong Learning.

Whilst working in many areas of the curriculum with a variety of young people of all ages in the early days of her work at the school, it soon became evident, that her experience and interest in a particular area became more and more valued. Numbers of students choosing to follow Art, Textiles and Graphic Design at GCSE was consistently high, and many appreciated the opportunity to work in a small group at a slower pace, which Dawn was able to provide within the classroom environment.

So many young people who might otherwise not have been able to produce their best work, were motivated by Dawn's encouragement and advice as well as her direction and reinforcement of messages delivered by the class teacher. Over the years she has shown so much patience (even though at times pushed to the limit by some!)

Whenever there was school production and costumes were needed Dawn was always happy to give her time to help with these too. She participated in the staff item for the school Eisteddfodau and worked on solo projects with individual pupils to help them participate too.

This doesn't apply solely to Art and Design; Dawn was also able to offer her experience of Catering to the Food Technology classes. Her calm and reassuring approach in these, often busy and noisy sessions, demonstrated to pupils that planning and keeping a cool head is what's needed. She helped them to organise themselves, to follow their recipes, to keep time when required, to work safely in the kitchen and also to clear up after themselves.

So many pupils have benefited from Dawn's presence in their classroom to provide insight and experience, establishing positive relationships and encouraging progress.

On behalf of all those pupils and the teachers who have worked alongside Dawn, Ysgol Uwchradd Tywyn gives thanks and acknowledgement of her contribution. Best Wishes from here on in Dawn and enjoy the next instalment.



Wythnos Ymwybyddiaeth Tlodi Misilf / Period Poverty Awareness Week 20-24/5/24

Yn ystod 'Wythnos Tlodi Misilf', gwnaethom gamau sylweddol i fynd i'r afael â tlodi misilf drwy roi cynhyrchion misilf ar gael i bob disgybl yn rhad ac am ddim. Dosbarthwyd y cynhyrchion hyn o Hafan yn ystod amser cofrestru, gan sicrhau mynediad hawdd a dirgel i'r holl fyfyrwyr mewn angen. Roedd y bocsys a ddarparwyd yn cynnwys amrywiaeth o eitemau hanfodol: tamponau, padiau misilf, padiau eco y gellir eu hailddefnyddio, cadachau colur, bag misilf y gellir ei aildefnyddio, a sach hot siocled. Yn ogystal, roedd pants misilf ar gael ac yn gyflym yn dod yn ddewis poblogaidd ymhliith y disgyblion.

Roedd yr adborth gan ein disgyblion yn gadarnhaol iawn. Nid yn unig y bu'r fenter yn ateb angen hanfodol ond hefyd yn meithrin amgylchedd cefnogol ac allgynhwysol. Mynegodd llawer o fyfyrwyr ddiolchgarwch am yr adnoddau a ddarparwyd, gan dynnu sylw at effaith y digwyddiad ar eu lles a'u bywydau bob dydd. Yn gyffredinol, rydym yn ystyried bod yr wythnos wedi bod yn hynod lwyddiannus ac yn fuddiol.

Mae tlodi misilf yn fater critigol sy'n effeithio ar fenywod, merched, a phawb sy'n misilfio ledled y byd. Mae'n cyfeirio at ddiffyg mynediad at gynhyrchion misilf priodol, cyfleusterau hyllendid, rheoli gwastraff diogel, ac addysg amserol ar fisilf a iechyd misilf oherwydd anawsterau ariannol. Gall y diffyg adnoddau hwn arwain at ganlyniadau difrifol, gan gynnwys colli cyfleoedd addysgol, absenoldebau gwaith, a dirywiad cyffredinol yn ansawdd bywyd.



During 'Period Poverty Week,' we took significant steps to address and combat period poverty by making period products available to all pupils free of charge. These products were distributed from Hafan during registration time, ensuring easy and discreet access for all students in need. The boxes provided included a variety of essential items: tampons, sanitary pads, reusable eco pads, make-up wipes, a reusable sanitary bag, and a sachet of hot chocolate. Additionally, period pants were made available and quickly became a popular choice among the pupils.

The feedback from our pupils was overwhelmingly positive. The initiative not only met an essential need but also fostered a supportive and inclusive environment. Many students expressed gratitude for the resources provided, highlighting the impact of the event on their well-being and daily lives. Overall, we consider the week to have been highly successful and beneficial.

Period poverty is a critical issue that affects women, girls, and all people who menstruate around the world. It refers to the lack of access to proper menstrual products, hygiene facilities, safe waste management, and timely education on menstruation and menstrual health due to financial difficulties. This lack of resources can lead to severe consequences, including missed educational opportunities, work absences, and a general decline in the quality of life.

Mae'r hawl i reoli eu cyfnod mislif heb gywiliydd neu stigma yn sylfaenol. Ni ddylai unrhyw fyfyrwr golli ysgol, ni ddylai unrhyw oedolyn golli gwaith, ac ni ddylai unrhyw berson golli allan ar fywyd bob dydd oherwydd nad ydynt yn gallu fforddio'r deunyddiau angenrheidiol i reoli eu cyfnodau.

Ymdrin â tlodi mislif nid yn unig yn ymwneud â darparu cynhyrchion ond hefyd yn ymwneud â meithrin diwylliant o ddealltwriaeth a chefnogaeth, gan dorri i lawr ar y tabŵs sy'n gysylltiedig â mislif, ac yn sicrhau y gall pawb ffynnu heb y rhwystrau a osodir gan dlodi mislif.





Period poverty affects not just the physical health of individuals but also their mental and emotional well-being. The inability to afford basic menstrual products often forces people to use inadequate or unsafe alternatives, leading to health issues such as infections. Furthermore, the stigma and shame associated with menstruation can exacerbate feelings of embarrassment and isolation.

It is essential to recognize that anyone who menstruates requires access to menstrual products and hygienic spaces to use them. The right to manage their menstrual period without shame or stigma is fundamental. No student should have to miss school, no adult should have to miss work, and no person should have to miss out on daily life because they cannot afford the necessary materials to manage their periods.

Addressing period poverty is not just about providing products but also about fostering a culture of understanding and support, breaking down the taboos surrounding menstruation, and ensuring that everyone can thrive without the barriers imposed by period poverty.

During Pride Month, pupils were given the task of creating a poster focused on the themes of "PRIDE" and "CELEBRATION."



The GCSE Geography course sees learners studying Cardiff as an example of a global city – a city that is connected and interacts through trade and communication with other places around the world. During the trip, year 10 were able to see the sights of Cardiff, such as the Principality stadium; the BBC Wales headquarters; Media Wales; Cardiff Universities; The Senedd; and Wales Millennium Centre, and to discuss if Cardiff should be classed as a global city. There was also an opportunity to see commuting taking place, with workers arriving into Cardiff by train, car, and bus, with a visit to the new Cardiff Bus Interchange. Changes in retail is another part of the GCSE course that the group were able to study in Cardiff, with everyone making the most of a visit to Cardiff Market, several shopping arcades, Queen Street and St David's Centre to take part in some retail therapy!

The group enjoyed a visit to Cardiff Bay and a walk over the Barrage to learn about the redevelopment of Cardiff Bay from 'Tiger Bay', the former docklands area of Cardiff that once exported coal around the world.

Fieldwork is a significant part of the GCSE Geography course, with the human Geography element of the fieldwork this year looking at change over time in an urban environment. Visiting Cardiff gave the group an opportunity to compare our capital city with our hometown, Tywyn. Data was collected at Queen Street and St Mary's Street on a Friday morning and late afternoon, with vehicle counts, pedestrian counts, Environmental Quality Surveys and noise levels using an app on their phone. This experience was a real eye opener for the group, seeing how busy the two main streets in Cardiff are on a Friday afternoon at rush hour!

It was not all work though as we enjoyed an evening of fun bowling at the Superbowl. A wonderful time was had by all!
