Prosiect Garddio Llys Cadfan Gardening Project

Diolch i Bethan Williams a'r grŵp Eco yn Ysgol Uwchradd Tywyn am eu gwaith caled a'u hymrwymiad i Brosiect Garddio Llys Cadfan.

Mae'r disgylion wedi bod yn mynchy Llys Cadfan yn wythnosol lle maent wedi dysgu am Dementia a gwerth yr hyn y bydd y prosiect gardd hwn yn ei olygu i'r preswylwyr. Gobeithio eich bod i gyd yn falch o'r hyn yr ydych wedi'i gyflawni.

Aeth y disgylion i'r diwrnod agored ochr yn ochr â Dilys Williams, staff a thrigolion Llys Cadfan a Liz Saville-Roberts AS ar Dydd Iau 11eg Ebrill 2024.

Dyweddodd Dilys Williams, Cydlynnydd y prosiect;

"O fewn tiroedd Llys Cadfan roedd llain fawr o o dir heb ei drin sydd wedi'i drawsnewid yn ardd flodau a gardd llysiau lle bydd preswylwyr yn helpu i gynnal y planhigion yn ogystal ag eistedd allan mewn twydd da i fwynhau'r bywyd gwylt a ddaw i mewn i'r ardd. Roedd y prosiect ond yn bosibl oherwydd cais llwyddiannus i Gronfa Gymunedol y Loteri Genedlaethol ar gyfer cylid a oedd i gynnwys cymunedau lleol yn y broses gyda'r unig bwrrpas o wella'r gofod er mwyn gwella iechyd a lles y rhai sy'n byw gyda dementia. Nawr bydd aelodau teulu a ffrindiau yn gallu eistedd yn yr ardd gyda'u perthnasau sy'n byw yn Llys Cadfan.

Roedd llawer o'r rhai sy'n byw gyda dementia yn Llys Cadfan yn mwynhau garddio pan oeddent yn iau a chyn i'r clefyd effeithio arnynt. Maen nhw'n cofio cyfnodau hapus yn gweithio yn eu gerddi yn tyfu a defnyddio yn y bwyd. Gellir efelychu hyn nawr yn Llys Cadfan gan ddefnyddio'r cynnrych mewn gweithgareddau pellach gyda'r preswylwyr. Mae'r ardd hefyd yn darparu amgylchedd tawel a diogel i bawb, hyd yn oed y rhai nad ydynt yn hoffi garddio. Mae eitemau synhwyraidd -gweledol, sain ac arogl hefyd wedi'u cyflwyno i'r ardd.

Agwedd allweddol o'r prosiect oedd cael cyfranogiad Ysgol Uwchradd Tywyn, gan ganiatâu I fyfyrwyr priodol ymweld â'r cartref a helpu yn yr ardd. Rhoddwyd sgwrs i fyfyrwyr Blwyddyn 11 ar 'Beth yw Dementia' i godi eu hymwybyddiaeth o'r clefyd hwn a gwella eu dealltwriaeth.

Mae'r Grŵp Eco o'r ysgol wedi gweithio'n galed ar yr ardd bob wythnos ac wedi bod o fudd mawr i'r prosiect.

Mae'r ardd o werth mawr i ofal a lles y rhai sy'n byw gyda dementia yn Llys Cadfan yn ogystal â chynnwys staff ac aelodau o'r gymuned leol."

Thanks to Bethan Williams and the Eco group at Tywyn High School for their hard work and commitment to the Llys Cadfan Garden Project.

Pupils have been attending Llys Cadfan weekly where they have learnt about Dementia and the value of what this garden project will mean to the residents. I hope you are all proud of what you have achieved.

The pupils attended the open day alongside Dilys Williams, Llys Cadfan staff and residents and Liz Saville-Roberts MP on Thursday 11th April 2024.

Dilys Williams, Co-ordinator of the project said;


"Within the grounds of Llys Cadfan there was a large plot of unused and uncultivated land that has been transformed into a flower garden and vegetable garden where residents will help maintain the plants as well as sitting out in good weather to enjoy the wildlife that will come into the garden. The project was only possible due to a successful application to the National Lottery Community Fund for funding and it was made clear that the project would involve local communities in the process with the sole purpose of improving the unused space to better the health and well being of those living with dementia. Now family members and friends will be able to sit in the garden with their relatives living at Llys Cadfan.

Many of those living with dementia at Llys Cadfan enjoyed gardening when they were younger and before the disease affected them. They recall happy times spent working in their garden; growing produce and using them in meals. This now can be replicated at Llys Cadfan using the produce in further activities with the residents. The garden also provides a calm and safe environment for all, even those who do not like gardening. Sensory items- visual, sound and smell have been introduced to the garden.

A key aspect of the project was getting the involvement of Ysgol Uwchradd Tywyn, allowing appropriate students to visit the home and help in the garden. A talk was given to Year 11 students on 'What is Dementia' to raise their awareness of this disease and improve their understanding.

The Eco Group from the school have worked hard on the garden every week and been a huge benefit to the project. The garden is of great value to the care and well being of those living with dementia at Llys Cadfan as well as involving staff and members of the local community."

Dros y misoedd dilynol, aeth gwahanol aelodau o'r Cyngor Eco i helpu bob wythnos. Yn ystod fy ymwelliadau, buom yn gwneud tasgau o blannu coed a blodau, i gywasgu'r llwybr troed o amgylch yr ardd.

Cawsom hefyd fynychu'r diwrnod agored, lle cawsom gyfle i gwrrd ag aelodau o Blaid Cymru a chael ein cyfweld am y gwaith yr oeddem wedi'i gwblhau ar gyfer yr ardd. Braf oedd gweld y trigolion oedrannus yn mwynhau'r ardd yr oedd gennym ni law yn ei chreu.

Gobeithiwn fod yr ardd gymunedol hon wedi creu gofod diogel, heddychlon ac ecogyfeillgar i'r henoed a'u hymwelwyr.

"Recently, the members of the Eco Council and I got given the opportunity to help build a community garden for the residents of Llys Cadfan in Tywyn.

It was exceedingly rewarding to play a part in helping the residents at Llys Cadfan to reconnect with the natural environment, and in turn, their memories.

We were first told about this opportunity by the head of this project, Dilys, and the manager of Llys Cadfan when the two came to an assembly to ask for volunteers to build the community garden. We then held a meeting with the members of the Eco Council to brainstorm ideas for the garden (for example, one idea was to install bird boxes for the trees). After doing this, we went to Llys Cadfan to meet Dilys and her team to see the progress they had already made and to share some of our ideas.

Over the following months, different members of the Eco Council went to help out every week.

During my visits, we did tasks from planting trees and flowers, to compressing the footpath around the garden.

We also got to attend the open day, where we were given the opportunity to meet members of Plaid Cymru and were interviewed about the work we had completed for the garden. It was lovely to see the elderly residents enjoying the garden which we had a hand in creating.

We hope that this community garden has created a safe, peaceful and environmentally friendly space for the elderly and their visitors.

Thank you for giving us this amazing opportunity, it was such a fulfilling experience, and we hope to remain involved in the future".

The students through Bethan's guidance and encouragement have given Llys Cadfan and those living with Dementia a very special gift that will enhance their lives.'
