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

Over the course of two days, the group developed essential outdoor skills, including how to pitch and pack away tents, and how to organise an expedition rucksack – carrying everything they'll need for the duration of their assessment. They also practised map reading and learned how to cook meals using a trangia stove.

Their training included two practice walks: the first around the Tywyn area, and the second a more challenging route in the Dolgellau area, climbing up to Foel Ispri. The team performed brilliantly, putting all their new skills into action with great enthusiasm and teamwork.





TRIP I PRIF YSGOL ABERTAWE TRIP TO SWANSEA UNIVERSITY

It was a day full of fun, giving pupils the chance to showcase their talents, express their skills, and work together as a team.





Ultimately, Opportunities Week offers something for everyone, ensuring that each student can find value and enjoyment in the activities.



Ble i ddechrau? Dylwn ddweud bod Mrs B (fel y'i gelwir yn fwy caffaeledig) wedi bod yn rhan annatod o YUT ers 1994, er iddi ymddangos gyntaf yn yr ysgol yn 1992 fel athrawes gyflenwi Mathemateg a TG. Ddigon teg dweud, dros fwy na 30 mlynedd, mae miloedd o ddisgyblion wedi cael eu dysgu ganddi (ac mae'n siŵr gen i bod rhai dal gyda'r creithiau!), ac wedi'u hysbrydoli gan ei brwd frydedd a'i hangerdd dros Wyddoniaeth, yn enwedig Cemeg.

Mae bod yn athro neu athrawes yn llawer mwy na dim ond cyflwyno'ch pwnc. Mae'n rhaid i athro 'berfformio' yn yr ystafell ddosbarth a dod o hyd i ffyrdd o ysgogi disgyblion a gwneud dysgu'n hwyl. Nid yw hynny'n rhywbedd sy'n dod yn naturiol i'r mwyafrif – ond roedd Mrs B yn gwneud iddo edrych yn hawdd ac yn ffordd gwbl naturiol o addysgu.

Wedi dweud hynny, mae disgyblion yn dysgu'n gyflym iawn bod yna fargen yn y fantol: cānt hwyl yn y wers Wyddoniaeth cyn belled ag eu bod yn ceisio cyflawni'r safonau uchel roedd hi'n disgwyl. Os yw hi'n gweithio'n galed i baratoi a chyflwyno, mae hi'n disgwyl i'r disgyblion weithio'n galed hefyd. Anwybyddwch hynny ar eich menter eich hun! (Sut ydych chi'n meddwl enillodd ei llysenw?)

Yn ystod ei hamser yn YUT, mae Mrs B wedi bod yn diwtor dosbarth, tiwtor blwyddyn, athrawes Gwyddoniaeth, Mathemateg, Addysg Gorfforol a TG, Pennaeth Gwyddoniaeth a Mathemateg, a Phennaeth Gwyddoniaeth CA4. Mewn pob un o'r rolau hyn, doedd dim carreg heb ei throi – roedd cynllunio, paratoi a gweithredu yn allweddol i gefnogi pob disgybl i gyflawni'r canlyniadau gorau posibl.

Wedi dweud hynny oll, mae Mrs B hefyd wedi dod o hyd i amser ar gyfer hamdden, ac mae hi wastad wedi bod yn chwarae wraig brwd. Yn ei dyddiau chwarae (pan gwrddais i gyntaf â Mrs B – yn yr 1980au. Dwi'n gwybod, 'da ni ddim mor hen â hynny, nac ydym?"), roedd hi'n chwaraewraig hoci medrus ac yn chwarae'n rheolaidd i Glwb Bro Dysynni. Gwrthwynebydd cadarn – ac roeddwn i'n falch fy mod i ar yr un tîm! Yn yr ysgol, roedd hi'n cymryd rhan yn rheolaidd mewn gemau staff vs disgyblion ar gyfer Sport Relief neu Children in Need – a chredwch fi, doedd neb eisiau gweld Mrs B yn rhuo tua chi, gyda neu heb y bêl!

Yn 2007 a 2008 buom yn cymryd rhan yn y "Moonwalk" yn Llundain, gan godi arian ar gyfer Cancer y Fron. Yn 2007, roedd Sue a'n cydweithiwr Beth Edwards yn rhan o'r criw marshalu – ac mae'n siŵr gen i iddyn nhw achosi peth dryswch! Ond roedden nhw hefyd yn darparu cymaint o gefnogaeth ac anogaeth, nid yn unig i mi yn cerdded y 26 milltir trwy strydoedd Llundain, ond hefyd i'r miloedd o gerddwyr, gwryw a benyw, yn gwisgo eu bra's addurnedig yn falch. Yn 2008, fe gymerodd y tri ohonom ran a chodi dros £1000 ar gyfer yr elusen. Mae hon yn achos sy'n agos at galonnau Sue a minnau.

Mae dros 30 mlynedd yn dipyn o dir i'w gwmpasu – ac rwyf ond wedi crafu'r wyneb. Felly.....

.....Dyma i Mrs Bowen, gyda'i côt labordy a'i dawn, cemegeydd ddewr gyda golwg danllwyd a dawn. Am dros 30 mlynedd bu'i ffiolau'n berwi, gan ddysgu meddyliau ifainc am wyddoniaeth yn ddi-ildio. Y tabl cyfnodol oedd ei chleddyf a'i tharian, mewn brwydr am wybodaeth doedd dim ildio'n bosib arni hi'n wirion.

Ei gwersi'n gymysgedd o hwyl a braw, atomau a moleciwlau'n cael eu hesbonio'n glir a thaw. Er bod rhai'n crynu dan ei disgwyliadau cry', roedd ei doethineb a'i hiwmor yn ennyn parch bob tro. O ddisgyblion ofnus i feddyliau ifainc craff, mae ei hetifeddiaeth yn fformiwl a fydd byth yn darf. Nawr Mrs B, newidia'r côt labordy am rywbeth mwy chic – ar gyfer ciniawau, teithiau a heriau newydd sy'n galw'n brith. Mwynha bob eiliad o'r cyfnod newydd hwn – mwynha'r rhyddid o'r (ymddeoliad cynnar) gyda gwên!

Mrs Sue Bowen

Where to begin? I ought to say that Mrs B (as she is more affectionately known) has been a fixture at YUT since 1994, though she did debut at the school in 1992 as a supply teacher of Maths and IT. Needless to say, in over 30 years, thousands of pupils have been taught by her (and I dare say still bear the scars) and have been inspired by her enthusiasm and passion for Science, specifically Chemistry.

Being a teacher is far more than just delivering your subject. A teacher has to 'perform' in the classroom and find ways of motivating pupils and making learning fun. That's not something that comes naturally to most, but Mrs B made it seem easy and the most natural way of teaching there is.

Mind you, pupils very quickly catch on that there is a trade-in; they get to have fun in Science as long as they strive to achieve the high standards that she expects. If she has to work hard in preparing and delivering, then she expects pupils to work hard too. Ignore that at your peril! (How do you think she earned her nickname?)

During her time at YUT Mrs B has been a form tutor, Year Tutor, teacher of Science, Maths, PE & IT, Head of Science & Maths, Head of KS4 Science. In all of these roles, no stone would be left unturned and planning, preparation and action would be key, in supporting all pupils in order to achieve the best outcomes for individuals.

All that said, she has also found time for leisure and Mrs B has always been a keen sportswoman. In her playing days (when Mrs B and I first met – in the 1980s. I know, we can't be that old can we?), she was a skilled hockey player and regularly played for Clwb Bro Dysynni. A formidable opponent, and I was pleased to be on the same side! At school she has regularly taken part in staff v pupils matches for Sport Relief or Children in Need and believe me, nobody wanted to see Mrs B hurtling towards them with or without the ball!

In 2007 and 2008 we took part in the Moonwalk in London, raising money for Breast Cancer. In 2007, Sue and our colleague Beth Edwards were members of the martalling crew, and boy did they cause havoc but provided so much encouragement and support, not just for me doing the 26 mile walk through the streets of London, but for the thousands of walkers, male and female, sporting their highly decorated bras proudly. In 2008 all three of us took part and we raised over £1000 for the charity. This is a cause that Sue and I hold dear.

Thirty something years is a lot of ground to cover and I have only scratched the surface. So.....

.....Here's to Mrs Bowen with her lab coat and her flair, a chemist so bold with a fiery glare.

For over 30 years her beakers did fizz, teaching young minds, the Science biz.

A periodic table, her sword and her shield, in the battle of knowledge she would never yield.

Her lessons a mix of fun and fear, atoms and molecules, crystal clear.

Though some may tremble when she expects, her wit and wisdom command respect

From scared little pupils to learned young minds, her legacy's a formula that forever binds.

Now Mrs B, swap that lab coat for something more chic, for lunches and trips and new challenges to seek.

Enjoy every moment of this new stage, relish the freedom of your (early) retirement age.

I recently caught up with Mrs B for some lunch and to reflect on her time at YUT. It's a big deal when you are preparing to leave a place which has been your second home for over 30 years. All the things that you do for the last time, bring a mix of emotions: excitement and relief but also trepidation and sadness. For Mrs B it has been no different but our chat was more to do with the challenge, fun, embarrassment and hilarity.

Greatest challenges:

keeping a straight face* when a pupil makes a hilarious comment that you want to high five but can't.

holding back from* telling parents that their 'genius child' isn't that much of a genius after all

biting your tongue* when people tell you how lucky you are to 'have all those holidays and finish work at 2.45 each day'

keeping abreast of technology which seemed to escalate particularly during 2020/21

*these are the challenges Mrs Bowen failed on!

Most embarrassing moments:

We have both experienced the usual awkward situations, such as chatting to a parent on parents evening and realising that you're talking about the wrong child (we are human!), or when a class demonstration doesn't quite go according to plan; or even when a pupil catches you thinking out loud and you go from respected teacher to 'nutter'.

Mrs B's most embarrassing moment was quite a recent event. As she was on her way to the gym with exam papers for the Year 10 mocks, she stepped in a hole and twisted her ankle, crashing to the ground like a sack of spuds under the gaze of the whole of year 10. As she went down, she blurted out a shameful expletive before face-planting the tarmac. Surprisingly, the year 10's missed the opportunity to mock and laugh out loud, but rather expressed some concern as Mrs B clambered to her feet (sorry.....foot) rather red-faced and grimacing in pain.

Greatest achievements

Professional: Developing an excellent Science department; inspiring students (particularly girls) to study 'Science A' Levels and to choose a career in Science;

Personal: arranging, planning and executing a variety of school trips and a Morocco expedition was the pinnacle of that. The groups had to raise their own funds in all manner of ways, as well as train for the best part of a year prior to the trip. The trip itself was a challenge for staff and pupils, coping with the heat and the terrain as well as trying to encourage and motivate the students to keep going.

Advice to your younger self that may be relevant for young teachers today

Always maintain a sense of humour, don't let the job take over your life and never lose sight of why you became a teacher.

If you could have a superpower when you retire, what would it be?

Definitely to be invisible! Imagine the pranks you could play, the conversations you could eavesdrop, including what people REALLY think about her!

What are you looking forward to in retirement?

Looking forward to being more flexible, having the freedom to plan and do the things I would like to do, outside school holidays. Visiting Steve and Tom in the States, long weekends away, shopping trips during the week to beat the crowds.... oh and of course, using her new super power.

Feeling a little bit nervous about the possibility that she may be bored (even though I know she won't be!)

After all the chat, I think it would be fair to say, that Mrs Bowen is an effective and inspiring teacher, who has enjoyed watching her pupils grow into Scientists, developing knowledge and skills and a love for the subject. 
